

In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed
the 12th day of March 1783, for the sale of Certain lands therein
mentioned, for the purpose of redeeming the Certificates of depre-
ciation &c. and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and
Seal of Office from John Lukens Esq^t Surveyor General for the
State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22nd day
of August 1783. The above tract of land containing Two hundred
and sixteen acres and 156 perches and allowance of 6⁶/₁₀₀ P Cent
for roads &c. was surveyed on the 10th day of June 1785, by
