In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783. the above tract of land containing two hundred and eighty eight acres and 125 perches and allowance of 6 p. Cent for roads &c was surveyed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
