In pursuance of an act of assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned, and by virtue of a commission under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor Gen^r bearing date at Philadelphia the 22nd day of August 1783.

The above tract of land containing Two hundred and Forty eight acres and 144 perches and allowance of 6 p cent for roads &c was surveyed on the 13th day of June 1785 by
