In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office from John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783. The above tract of land containing Two hundred and sixteen acres and 156 perches and allowance of 6. p. Cent for roads &c. was surveyed on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by
