

## Part of District No 3.

In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of certain lands therein mentioned & by virtue of a Commission under the hand and seal of Office from John Lunens Esqr Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783.  
The above tract of land containing two hundred & sixteen acres and 156 perches and allowance of 6p Cent for roads &c. was surveyed on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785. by
