



A Draught of a Tract of land (being part of a larger Tract) called "Batchelors Hall" situate in York Township York County. Resurveyed the 3<sup>rd</sup> Day of March 1797 by the lines formerly run by William Matthews late Deputy Surveyor dec'd in pursuance of Two Warrants, one granted Charles O'Harra dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1750, and the other to Adam Hineke dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1766. Containing Ninety Three acres and a quarter and allowance of Six p Ct. for roads &c.
