



A Draught of two peices or tracts of Land situate lying Contiguous in the Township of Martick Lancaster County, the peice A containing 50<sup>ac</sup> of the usual allowance of six pr Cent for roads &c<sup>a</sup>. (Resurveyed according to the old lines & corners said to be made by a Deputy of Mr Oookson for a certain Patrick M. Garr by virtue of a Warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1749) the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1793 for John Ort in right of the said Patrick M Garr (By virtue and agreeable to an Order from the Board of Property dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 1792, and the piece B containing 54<sup>ac</sup> & 30<sup>ps</sup> of allowance, also surveyed on the aforesaid 15<sup>th</sup> day of January — for s<sup>d</sup> John Ort agreeable to the direction of the aforesaid order from the Board of Property and by virtue of a Warrant dated the Seventh day of April A.D. 1791 which warrant it appears has not been represented to the said Board &c<sup>a</sup> )
