



A Draught of two pieces or Tracts of Land situate lying contiguously in the Township of Martick Lancaster County. The piece A containing 50<sup>2/3</sup> and allowance. Resurveyed (According to <sup>old</sup> lines & corners said to be made by a Deputy of Mr Cookson for a certain Patrick Mkle Carr by virtue of a Warrant dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of December 1749) The 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1793 for John Ort in right of s<sup>d</sup> Carr. by virtue and agreeable to an Order from the Board of Property dated the Sixth day of August 1792. And the piece B. containing 54<sup>2/3</sup> of 30<sup>2/3</sup> and allowance. also surveyed on the aforesaid 15<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup>. agreeable to the direction of the aforesaid Order from the Board of Property, and by virtue of a Warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March (or April) 1791. Which Warrant it appears has not been Represented to the said Board &c
