


FORM NO. 1.



A Draught of a Tract or peice of Land situate in Hamilton Township Franklin (late Cumberland) County. Containing Thirty four acres and One hundred and fifty three perches and the usual allowance of Six p. Cent for roads &c. being part of a tract of Three hundred and twenty seven acres and allowance which was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted Samuel Moorehead dated August 25<sup>th</sup> 1738.

Resurveyed and laid off from the other parts of the tract for Daniel Huston November 5. 1811
