Situate on the waters of Little Conlaut Creek in followfield township Crawford County and at the time of Surveying the said Michael Miller actuly living on the same with his family, and had a house fit for the habitation of man, and had Clered fenced, and in a good state of Cultivation upwards of thirty acres. of the Land
