S. in pursuance of an application No. 2762 bearing date the 12th day of February 1767 granted to Philip Snider. Since Resurveyed & divided &c. Now on the 29th Day of March A. D. 1839 Examined & Corrected the above &c. at the request of Mathias Neas, the present owner, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation.
