

Situate in Derry Township Mifflin County surveyed on the 24<sup>th</sup> October 1766, in pursuance of an order of survey granted to Joseph Knight No 561 dated August 1<sup>st</sup> 1766 Divided by David Hough D.S. and examined and corrected this 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1842 and found to contain as above.
