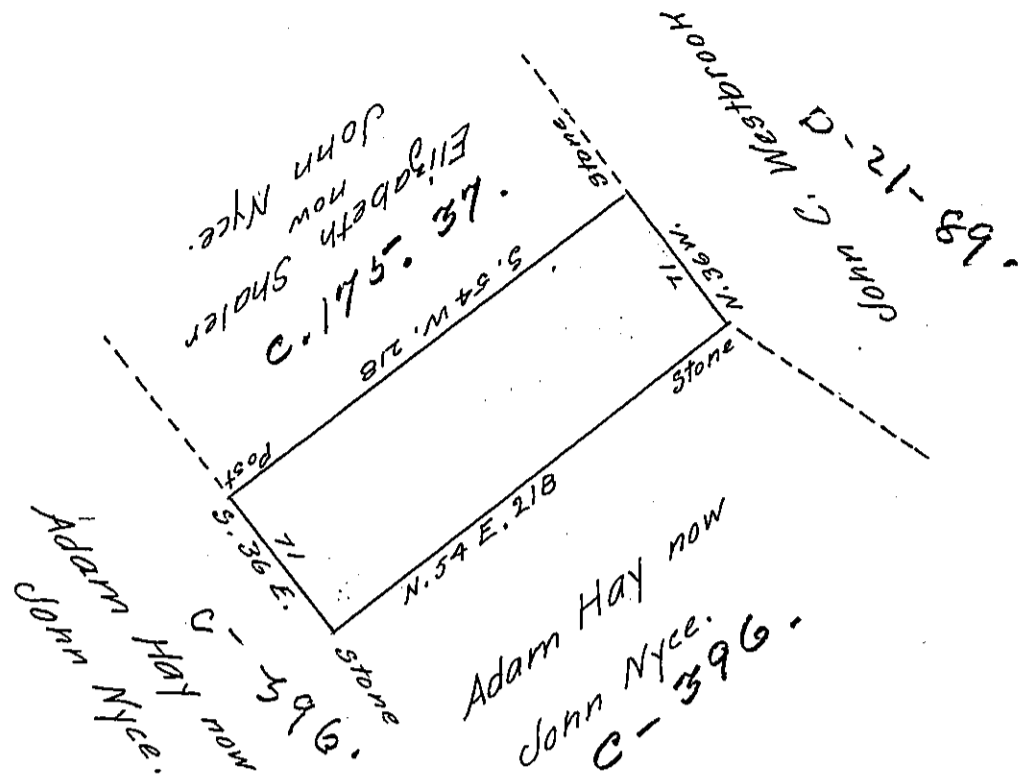

Westbrook on the North East Containing Ninety one acres and forty one perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
