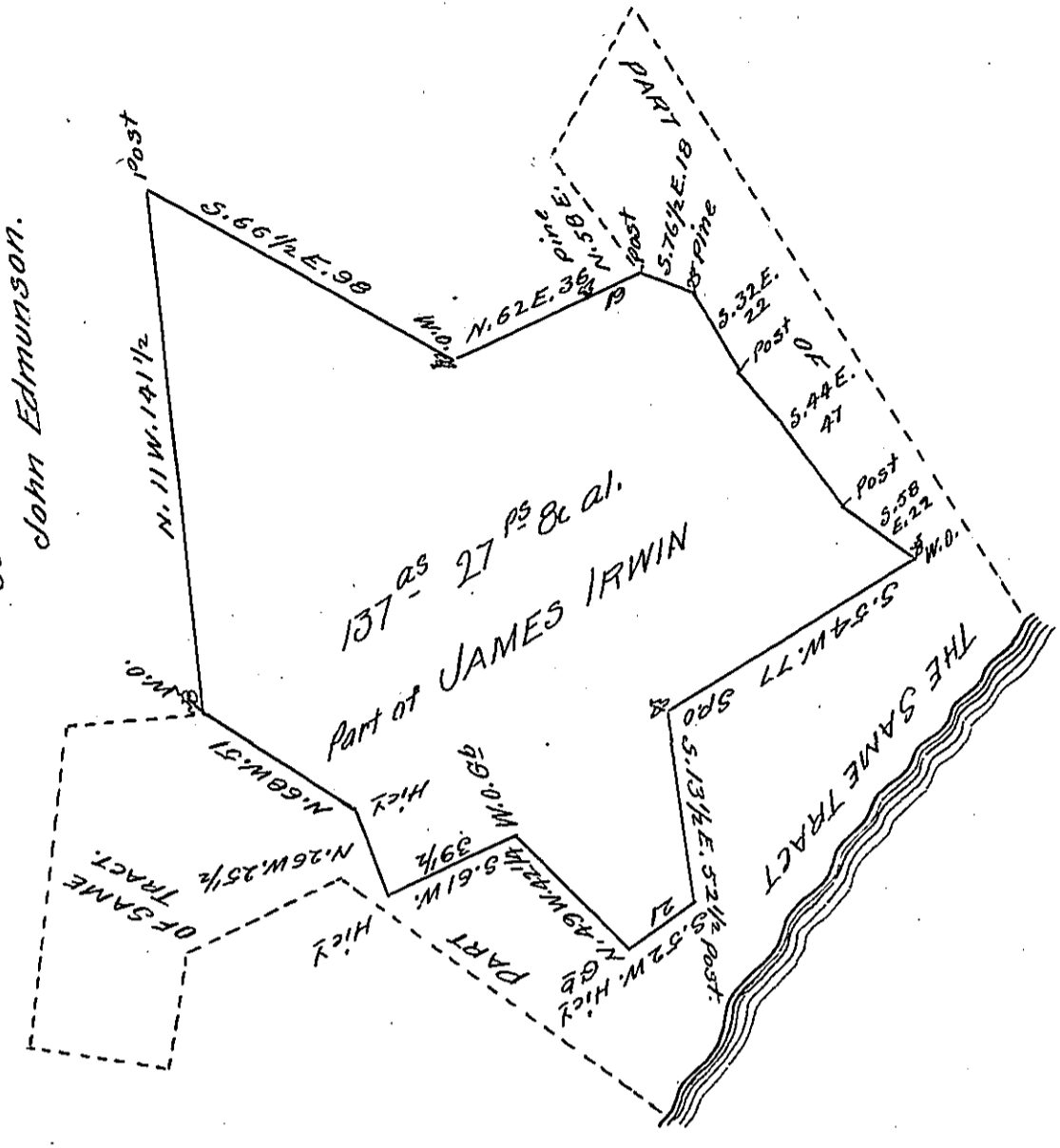

The<sup>s</sup> part was surveyed & divided off 15<sup>th</sup> December 1813, under the direction of Archibald Fleming then D. Surveyor which I have examined & find correct.
