



Situate in Schuylkill township Schuylkill county containing four hundred and one acres and twenty perches and the allowance of six per cent, said to have been surveyed on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> November 1793 granted Nicholas Nachbar, as appears by an official copy of the return of Survey made into the Surveyor General's office. Resurveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> September 1826 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 30<sup>th</sup> March 1826.
