



A Draft of one hundred and seven acres and fifteen perches of land with six per Cent for Roads situate in Decatur township in Mifflin late Cumberland county, which is part of a tract of land surveyed 19th June 1768 in pursuance of an order to Philernan Dickinson dated 6th June 1767 N^o 3829 said to contain 216^{ac} & 24 perches, Resurveyed and divided 16th November 1803 when it was found to contain only 214^{ac} & 5 perches with 6 P^{er} Cent as appears from Official papers remaining in my Office. Examined 28th November 1815.
