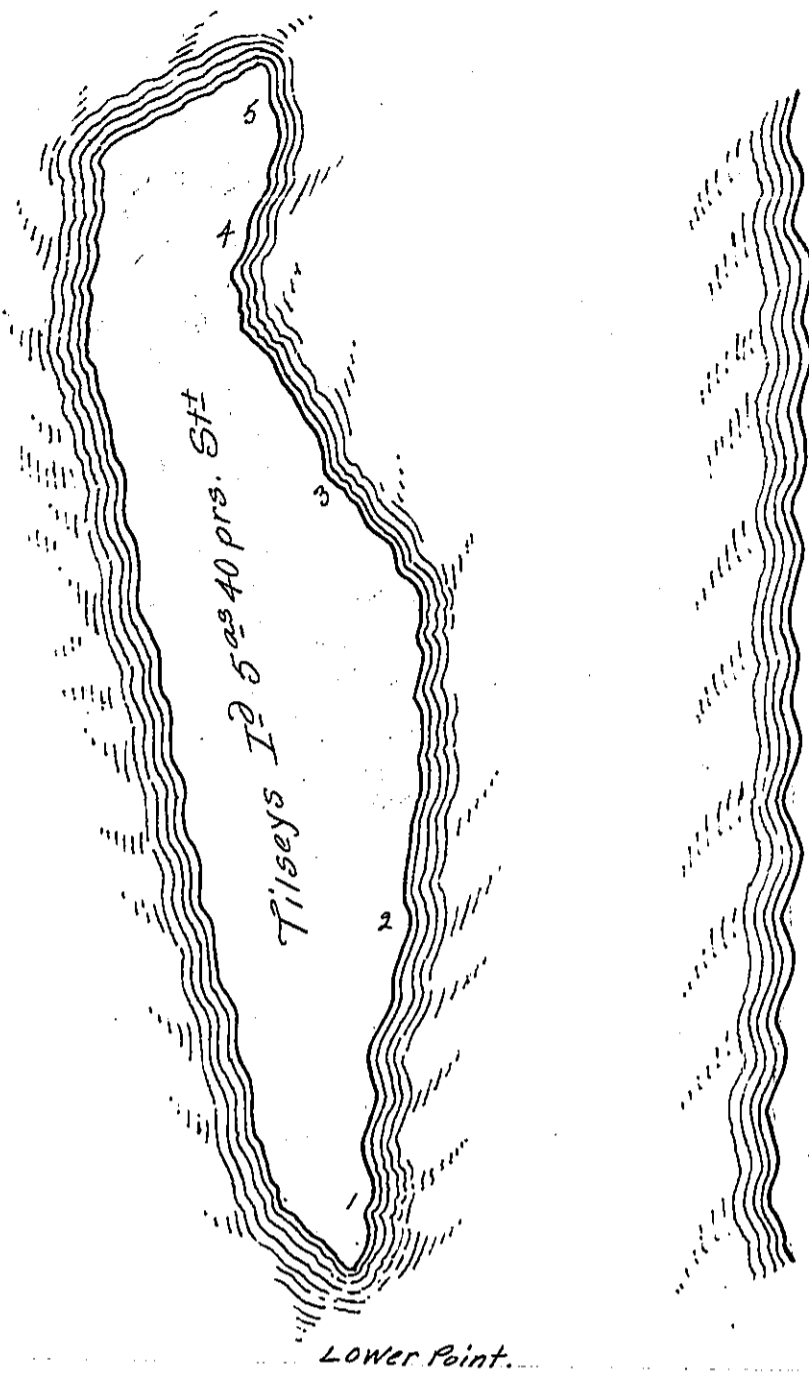

Dauphin Shore.

Surveyed September 1st 1815 for William Moorhead the above described Island Situate in the River Susquehanna in Halifax Township Dauphin County called Tilseys Island in Berrys Falls opposite the end of Berry's Mountain and the upper end of said Moorheads plantation and about twenty ~~five~~ perches from the main land Containing Five acres and a quarter strict measure by his Warrant of the 16th — August 1815.
