Compartment "A" is a part of a tract of land granted to David Evans in pursuance of an ~~order~~ Application N<sup>o</sup> 1969 dated April 3, 1769 containing 201 acres and 140 perches and allowance. Compartment "B" is a part of a tract of land granted to Paul Fooks in pursuance of an application N<sup>o</sup> 1916. dated April 3 1769.
