



A Draught of a survey executed October 5th 1824 for James Morrison Jr. Situate in Mifflin Township Allegheny County on the waters of Liewis run; by virtue of a warrant in the name of James Morrison Jr. dated 23^d of April 1792. Containing one hundred and four acres and fourteen perches and allowances of Six p^r—for Roads & ce. Note,—At the time of executing the survey the said James Morrison with his family resided thereon and had at least forty acres in a state of Cultivation
