



Situated on the Waters of redstone creek, and on the Head waters of Harpers Run in Franklin Township Fayette County and Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of November, <sup>1785</sup> In pursuance of a ~~Warrant~~ Certificate Granted by the Commissioners appointed by the state of Virginia &c. of which the following is a true Copy. We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio: do hereby Certify that Robert McLaughlin is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Yohogania on the main Road Leading from Gists to Devores Ferry to include his settlement made in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and seventy. Given under our Hands at Redstone old fort the Third day of December 1779 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
