Whereas a Certain Abraham Peters Claims part of the above Mentioned Tract of Land by Warrant Dated the 26th day of June 1788 as Andrew Middletons Warrant Calls only for 150 ac and found to be 344 3/4 ac for Which Reason the Enclosed Deposition was Taken as I was ordered by the aforesaid Andrew Middletons Warrant to Run Round the old Lines as they have been Run in Thomas Cooksans D.S. Time.
