



Situate on the Halfway run formerly in Manchester then in Newbury, then in Dover, but now in Cone-
wago township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 236^{acs} & 86 Perches and
Allowance, Originally Surveyed on the 9th day of May 1744 by the then Deputy Surveyor in
pursuance of a Warrant granted to Daniel McLaughery for 100^{acs} dated the 13th day of
September 1743. Resurveyed by the Old lines on the 16th day of November 1819 at the re-
quest of the present owners George Aughenbach & George Numan who desired the same
to be returned for confirmation.
