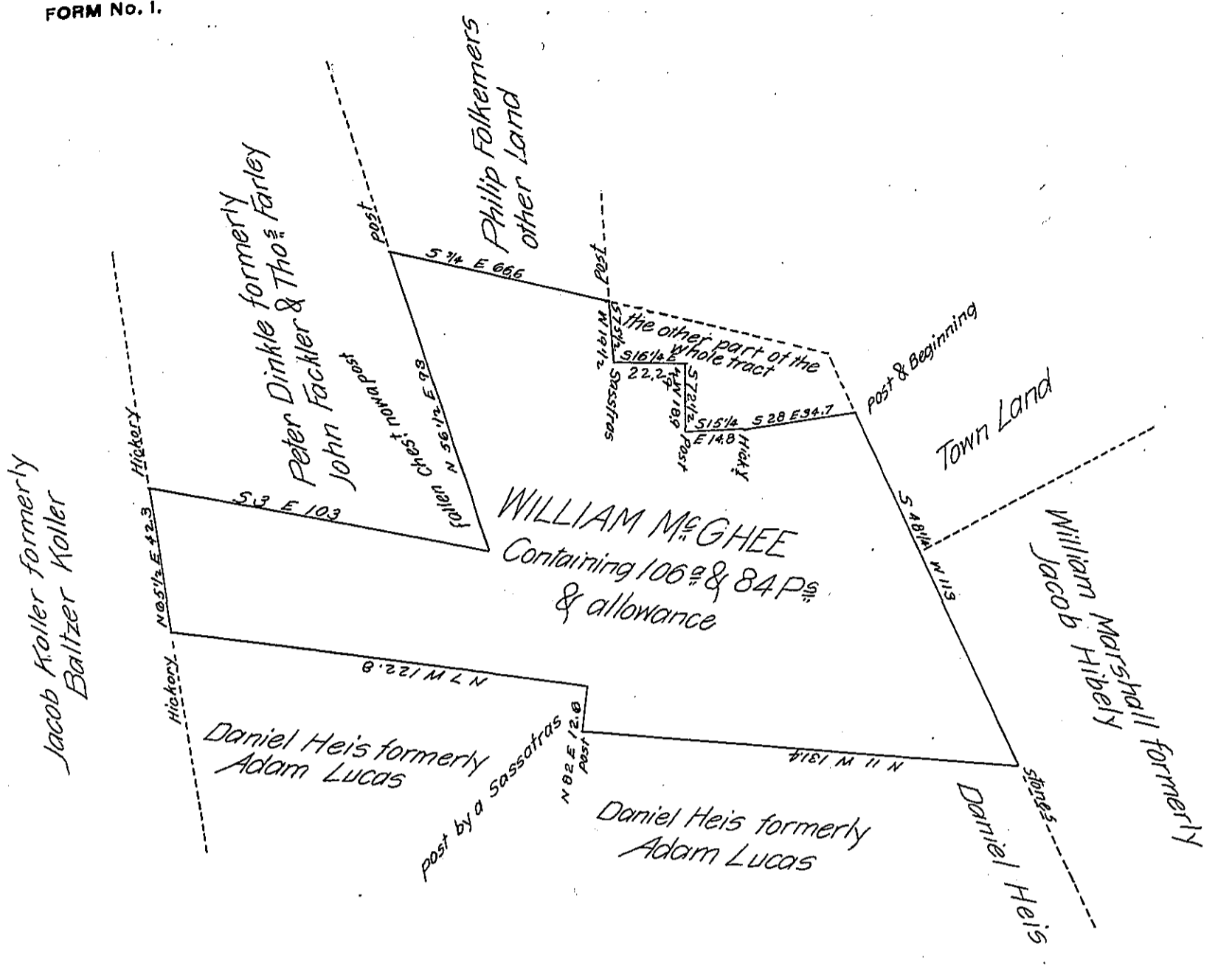

In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{ac} Granted to William McGhee bearing date the 1st day of June AD 1762 And now Resurveyed and divided off from the said Larger tract of land on the 27th day of May AD 1811 for and at the Request of Philip Folkemer the present owner who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation.
