



A Draught of an Island Situate in the River Susquehanna Manor township Lancaster County about 250 yards from the Lancaster Shore opposite to lands of Jacob Withers and George Brenner on the said Lancaster Shore (ob) Lying (ob) 150 yards East of Mussers big Island on which Island there is a fishing house Erected by John Dick and Charles Evans about seven years ago Called Little Walnut Island Containing One acre Strict Measure. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the Eighteenth day of September Anno. Dom. 1822.
