



By virtue of an order to Peter Mather for Fifty acres more or less dated 17 March 1757, The above described Tract of Land was Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1757 by Thomas Lightfoot the then Deputy Surveyor, as appears by his Field Book Situated in the Township of Tredyffren Chester County containing Ninety Six Acres & three quarters of an Acre with allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads &c.
