The above is a draft of a tract of land situate in Mahoning Township Merder County. Surveyed the eighth day of November 1826. In Pursuance of the actual Settlement residence and improvement of Hugh McKean the present applicant who was residing on it with his family at the time of Surveying. Survey Contains four hundred and twenty six acres and forty perches with the usual allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. on this tract there about one hundred acres cleared land under Cultivation, Houses and Barns and three families on it.

I hereby officially Certify that from the books and documents in my Office. it does not appear that this land now applied for, has been granted or Surveyed to any person other than the present applicant by Warrant or otherwise, although it is said it was a part Jo^s Swearengen's Claim, and that he (Swearengen lost it at the Board of Property many years ago). Hugh McKean says his Settlement Comenced in May 1798.
