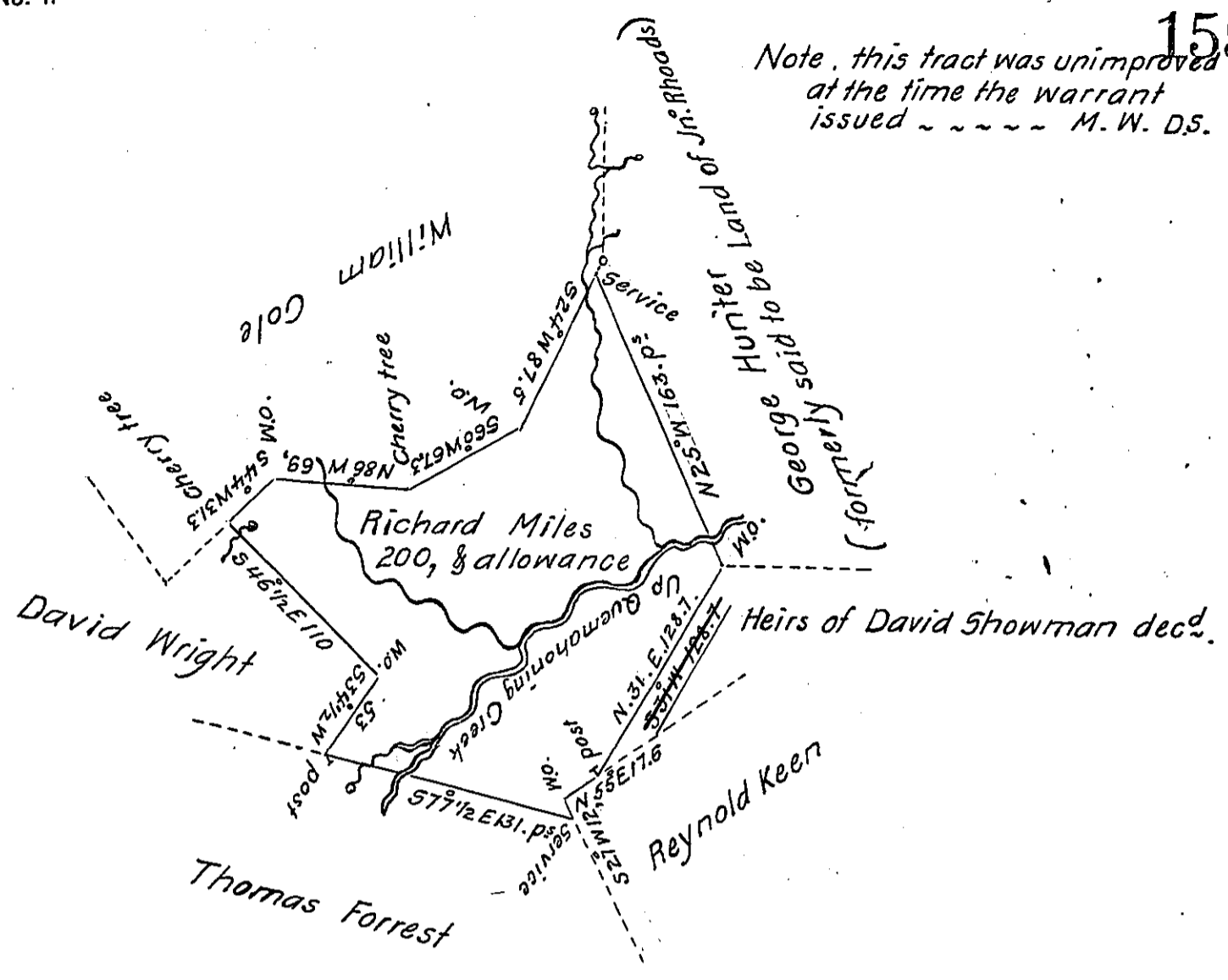

In pursuance of a warrant dated 15th July 1784 Granted to Richard Miles for 200^{as} as appears by his Official Draught thereof remaining in my Office, & Certified this 10th day of May 1823
