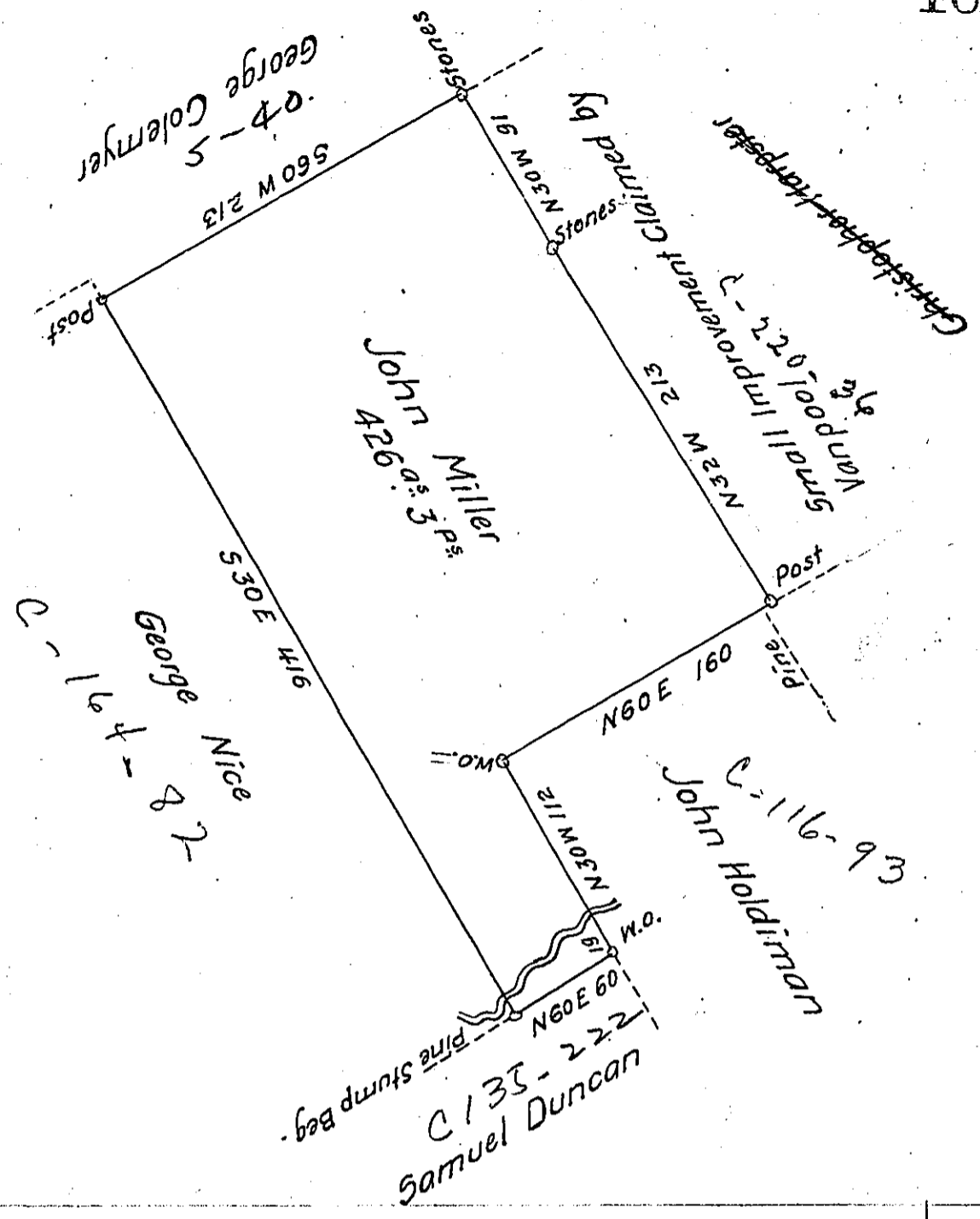

The Draught of a tract of land Situate in Ferguson Township  
 Centre County Containing four hundred and twenty six Acres, three perches  
 and allowance of Six per Cent. - Surveyed the 31<sup>st</sup> day of March 1815 in  
 pursuance of a warrant granted the said John Miller dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day  
 of November 1814. ~

The improvements on the above described tract of land, at the  
 time of making the Survey consisted, of a dwelling house & Stable, an  
 Orchard of bearing Apple Trees. about Seventy five Acres of Gleared land,  
 the said John Miller and his family residing on the same, and I believe  
 has resided on the same ever since the Spring of the year 1791. ~
