



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 19th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John M: Masters for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 10th day of February 1794 Adjoining John Findley to the Eastward and on the South Side of the Conaquesing Creek including a part of said Creek North and West of the River Ohio Alleghany and Conowango Creek Called Robuck Containing four hundred thirty two acres and One quarter of an Acre together with the usual allowance of Six p: Cent for Roads.
