

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 6th January 1785 Surveyed the 26-September 1786 to William Mac Pherson the above described tract of land situate on a branch of Coneshoughs Creek about one mile and an half from Deleware River in Upper Smithfield Township Northampton County Containing four hundred and four Acres Seventy five perches and the allowance of Six P. Cent &c.
