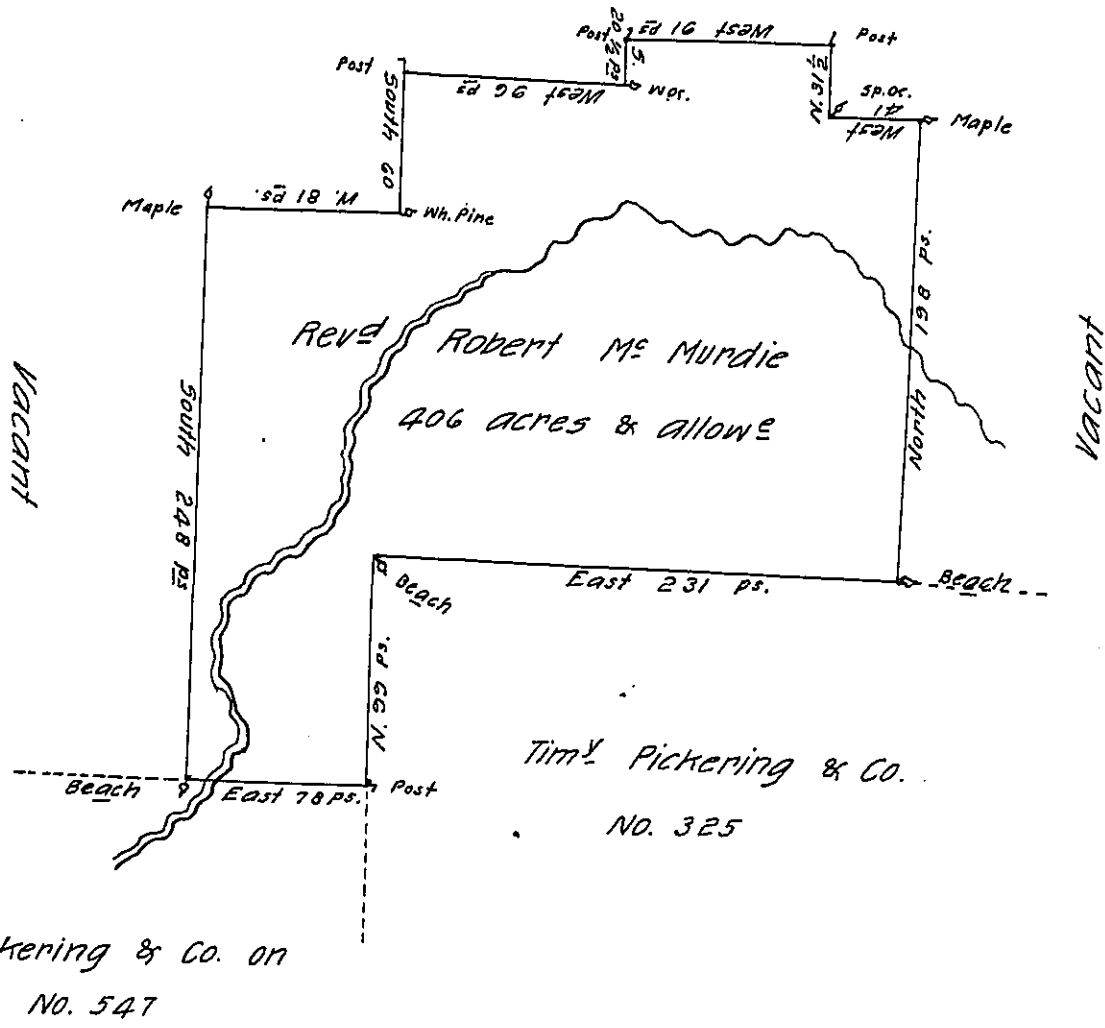


VACANT



Surveyed for the Revd Robert Mc Murdie on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May 1786, the above described tract of Land Containing four hundred and six acres of Land and allowance of six p. ct. for Roads & ca. Situate about three quarters of a mile West, from the thirty six mile tree from the old purchase Line, in the Fifth District in Northumberland County, on Warrant for 406 acres. No. 571. Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785.
