



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor, Dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of 7<sup>mo</sup> Anno. Dom. 1737

The above described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto Thomas Nicholas in the township of Cumru in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a white oak thence South 60 Degrees West by vacant Land 180 perches to a hickery, thence North 30 Degrees West by vacant Land 236 perches to a small Black oak, Thence North 60 Degrees East by vacant Land 180 perches to a Spanish oak. Thence South 30 Degrees East by vacant Land and the Land of John Jones 236 pches to ye place of Beginning. Containing two hundred and fifty acres beside ye allowance of six p Cent for Roads.
