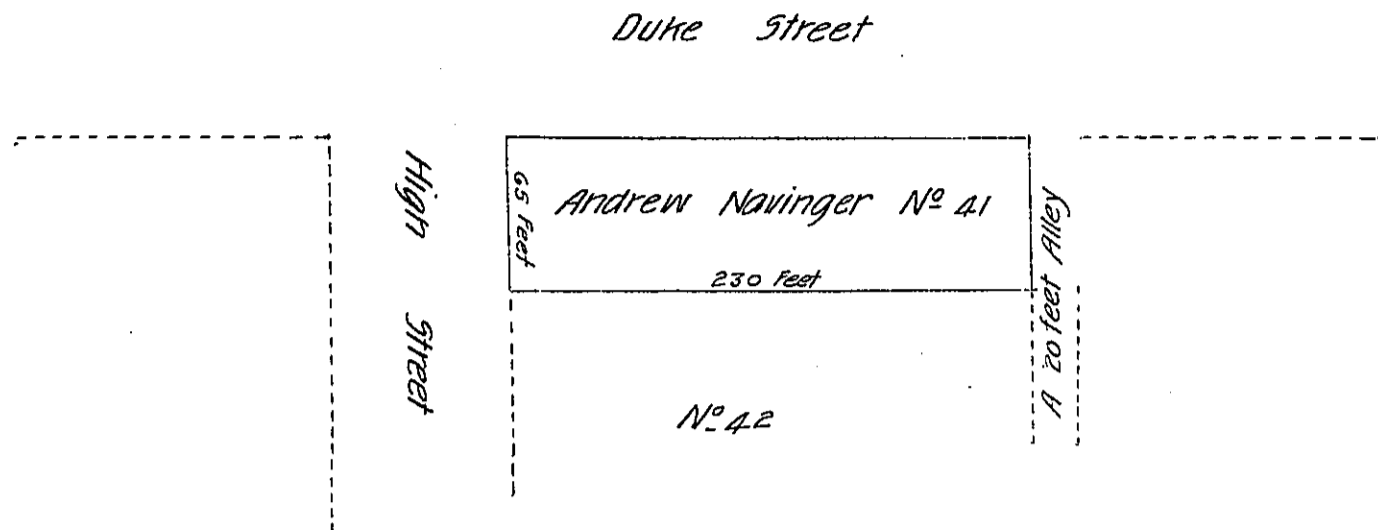


FORM NO. 1.

Entered on the Plan of the said Town and survey'd for Andrew Navinger, who has built an House on the same according to the Conditions of Settling the Town.
