



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 24th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Samuel McLean for 400 Acres of Land Dated April the 14th day 1792 Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the West Side of Big Beaver Creek on Narrows Run Adjoining Land Granted to John McPherson Called Horse Shoe Containing four Hundred Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent.
