



The above is a Draught of a Survey, Returned in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Conrad Oller for eight Acres of land Dated July 30th 1830 Containing Seven Acres and 131 perches and Allowance of six per Cent for highways Situate in Nottingham Township Washington County on the Waters of Mingo Creek, It is the same tract of land which I Surveyed June 29th 1829 on a Warrant granted to Stephen Snyder for one Acre of land Dated June 19th 1829 and Returned by Snyder about that time, Note at the time of Survey there was a house on the ground and grain growing in the field said to belong to Conrad Oller, the house was not Occupied by any person.
