



Surveyed to Hamlet Totten on the 26th day of May 1838 the above described tract of land containing three hundred and Seventy Six Acres One hundred twenty nine perches and Allowance of Six per cent ~~and~~ Situate in Wayne Township Armstrong County. Being part of a larger Survey Warranted to Timothy Pickering, Samuel Hodgdon, Duncan Ingaham, and Tench Cox containing in all Six hundred ninety-six acres and thirty three perches and Allowance of Six percent Surveyed to them on the 29th day of May 1786 in pursuance of a Warrant dated May 17th 1785 as appears from papers filed in the office.
