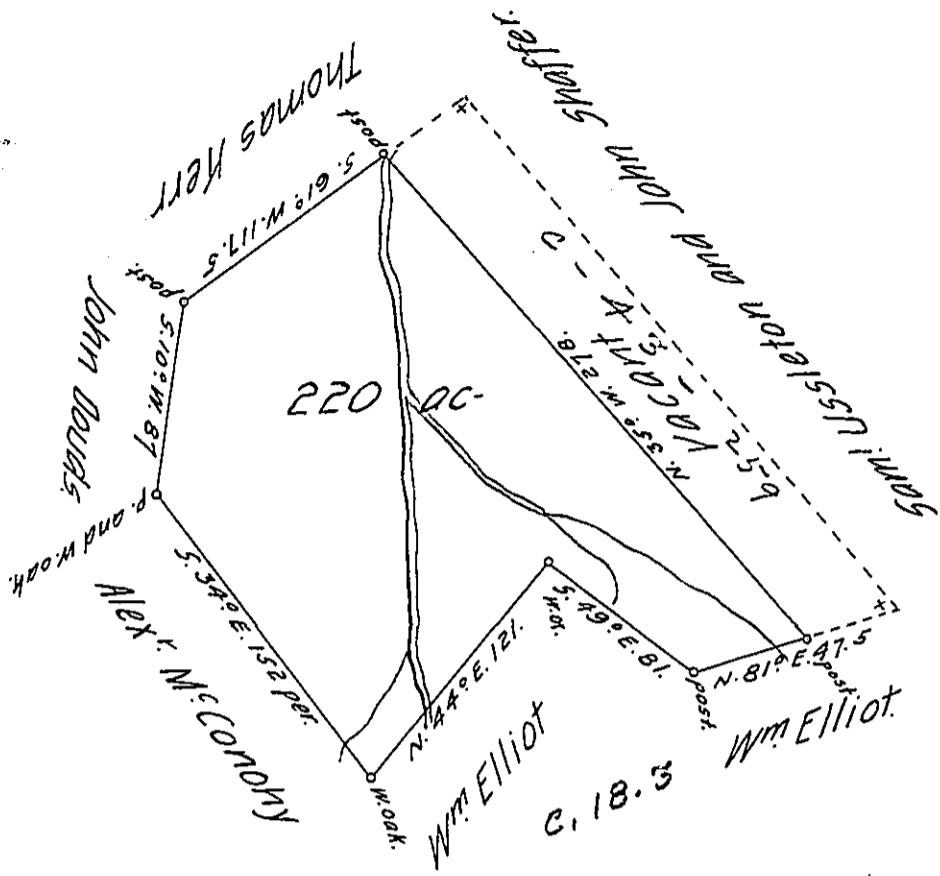

D. 1831, adjoining Lands of said M<sup>c</sup>Conohy, Saml Ussleton, Thomas Kerr and Wm Elliot, as above Situate on the Waters of Raccoon Creek, Moon township, Beaver County, containing two hundred and twenty Acres and the allowance of Six per Cent &c.
