Supposed to be an undrawn Lot Surveyed for John McLean in pursuence of his Improvement and Actual Settlement and Residence thereon with his family. Containing one hundred and ninety eight Acres and one hundred and Seventeen perches and Allowance of six percent for Roads &c.
