



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Novr. 20th, 1833, for the heirs of William McCaslin, Decd. Containing ninety nine Acres & 35 perches, Strict measure, Situate in Hanover Township, Washington County, on the waters of Kings Creek, being part of an Original Survey called Contention, executed March 17th 1786, in pursuance of a Certificate for 400 Acres granted to George McCaslin, Decd and duly Entered &c. The Dotted lines represent the balance of the tract which has lately been surveyed & Returned for Robert K. McCaslin and Alexr. McCaslin, heirs of George McCaslin aforesaid.
