In pursuance of an act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783, for the sale of certain Lands therein mentioned; and by Virtue of a Commission to me directed under the Hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens, Esquire, Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania, bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August 1783, the above Tract of Land containing two hundred and sixteen Acres, and one hundred & fifty six perches and allowance of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c, was Surveyed on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785.
