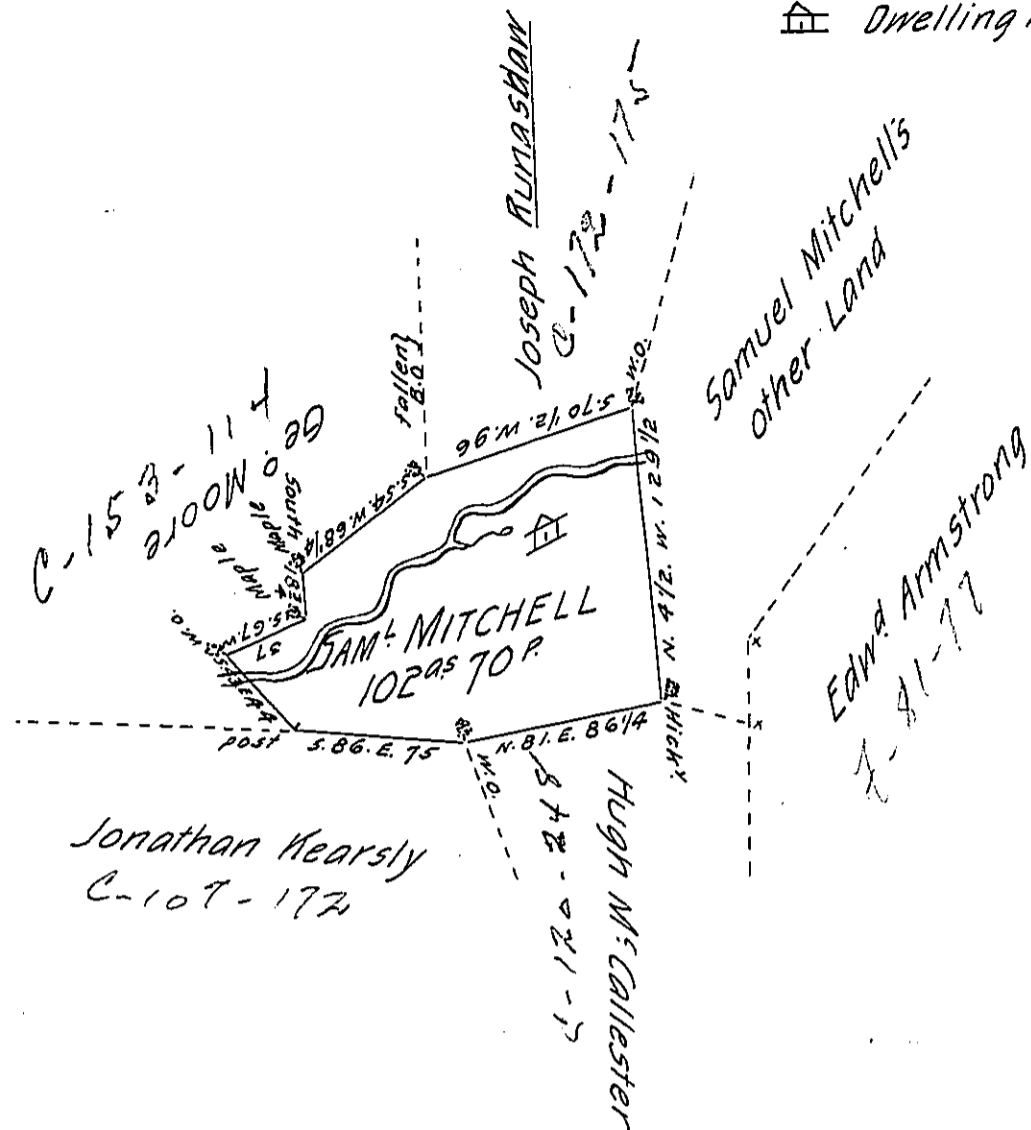


Note. Sam! Mitchell's Dwelling house

 of April 1767, by W^m Maclay late Deputy Surveyor, said to Contain 110⁴/₁₀ Acres &c.
 In pursuance of an Application N^o 847 Granted to Samuel Mitchell dated the 12th
 day of August 1766.

Resurvey^d the 25th & 26th of June 1805, and appears to Contain One hundred
 and two acres and 70 perches and the Allowance of Six ⁷/₁₀₀ Cent for roads &c. In
 pursuance of the aforesaid Application Directed to me for Execution.
