In Pursuance of an At of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain Lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of A Commission Under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukens, Esq<sup>r</sup>, Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783, the above tract of Land Containing two hundred & Sixteen Acres, one hundred & fifty six Perches and Allowance of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads &c. was Surveyed on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785, by
