



A & B. Was Surveyed the 29th November 1766. to Joseph Biery by virtue of a warrant dated the 20th December 1753. Cont^g 51 1/2^{ac} & allowance. C. Was Surveyed & Returned on the said 29th November 1766. to Joseph Biery by virtue of a Warrant dated the 4. June 1750.

A. Was Returned by James Scull late D.S. on the said warrant dated the 20. December 1753. by which the tract B. is excluded, but as it appears by the several draughts, by the survey of 1766 and by the conveyances of the land (herewith shown to the Board of Property) that the whole of A & B was included and ought to be returned on the said warrant. Therefore the above is now returned & submitted to the honourable the Board of Property for Acceptance.

By Virtue of a warrant dated the 20. December 1753. There was Surveyed the 29. November 1766. to Joseph Biery (alias) Peery the above described tract of land, situate in Longswamp Township, Berks County Cont^g. fifty one acres a quarter & Allowance of six PCent for roads &c.
