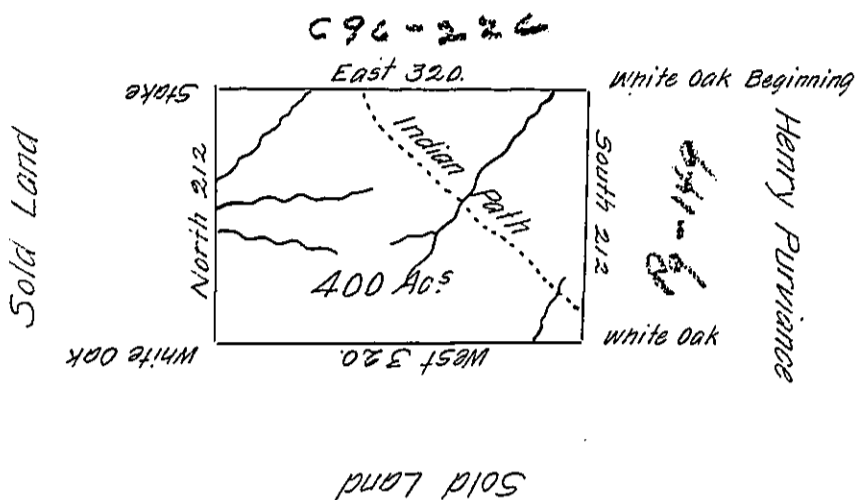

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 7th of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Robert Purviance for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th of January 1794, Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Conaquesing Creek Adjoining Land Granted to Francis Johnston, Called Durham Containing four Hundred Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads.
