



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 26th of January 1795. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Joseph Potts for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th of January 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Big Beaver Creek Adjoining Land Granted to Samuel Rutter Called Salve Containing four Hundred and twenty four Acres three quarters and thirty one poles together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^r Cent for Roads.
