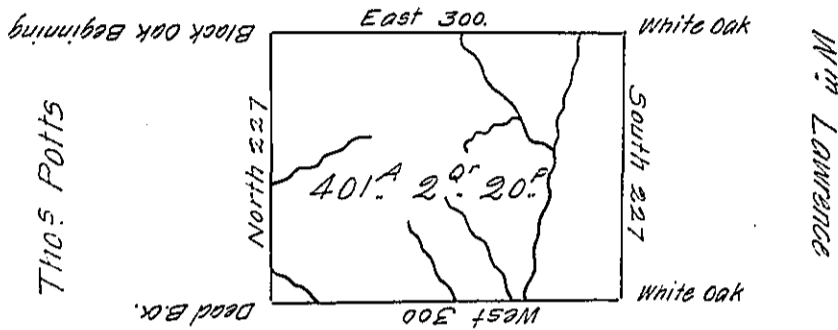

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 27<sup>th</sup> of January 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to William Potts for 400 Acres of Land Dated January the 4<sup>th</sup> 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Conaquenesing Creek Adjoining Land Granted to Thomas Potts Called Deer Park Containing four Hundred and one Acres one half and twenty poles together with the Usual Allowance of Six p<sup>r</sup> Cent.
