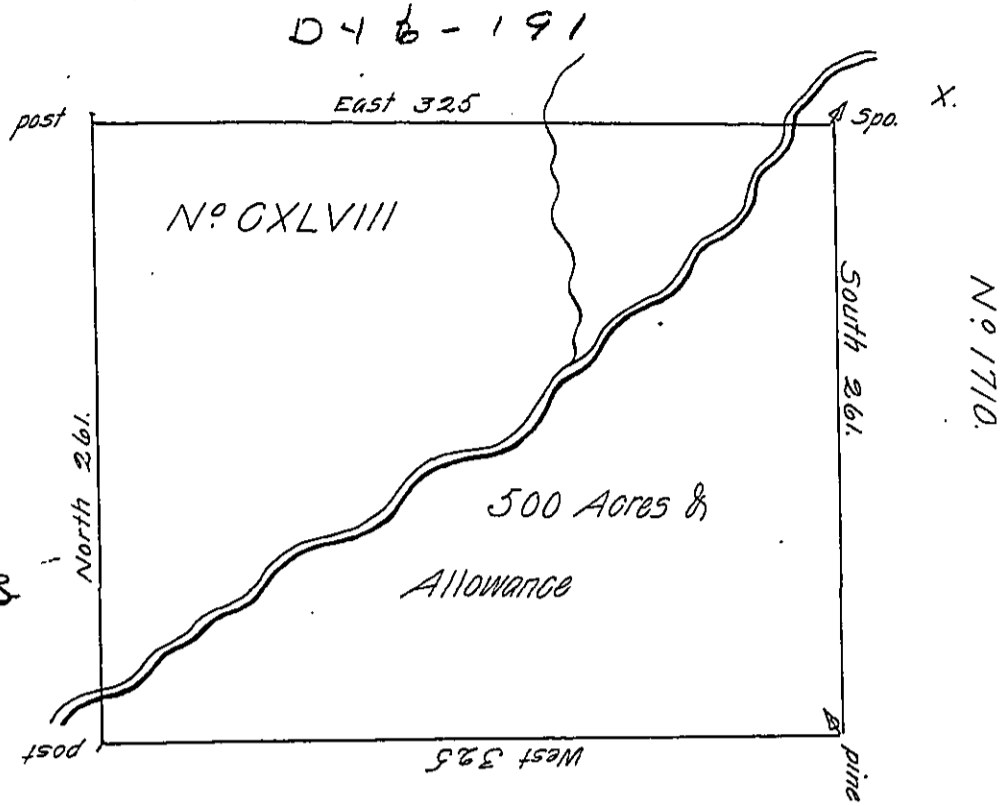

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of <sup>\*</sup>February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth", and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of November 1785, the above described Tract of five Hundred acres of land, and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c.
