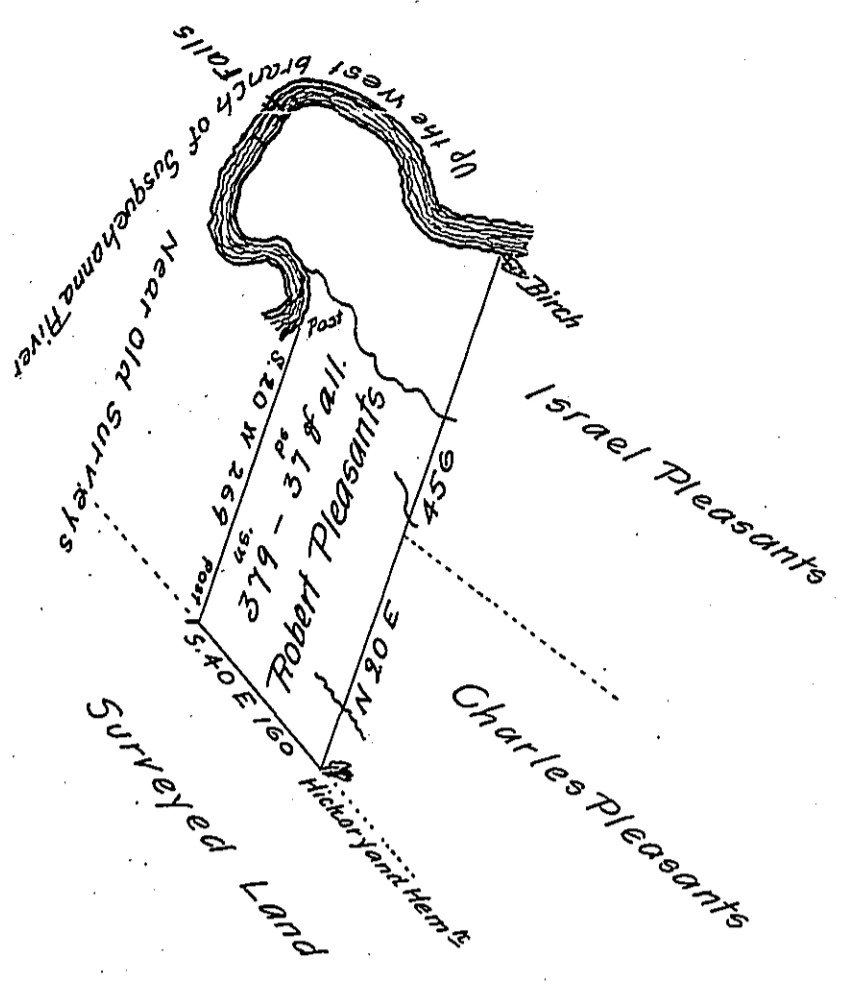

 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January 1793
