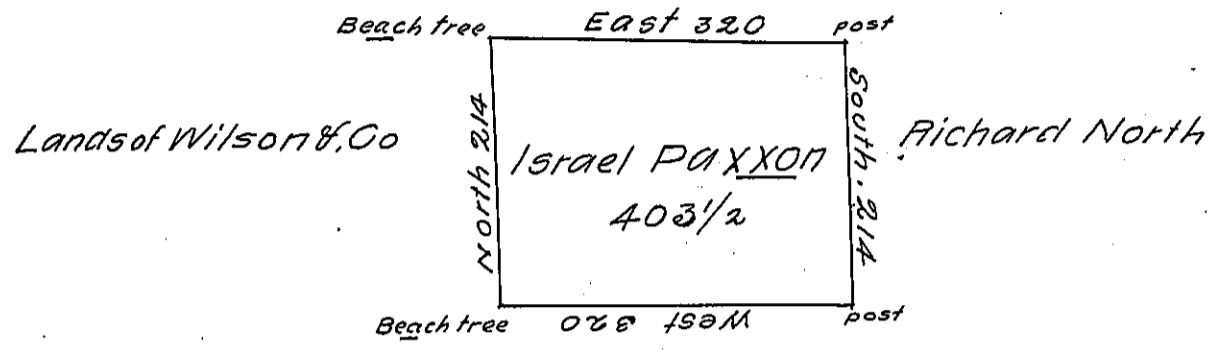


Thomas Penrose
