By Virtue of two warrants the one in the name of Godfrey Orwick dated the 3- day of June 1747 and the other in the name of Casper Beeking dated the 27. day of March 1751. there was survey'd by Order of Edward Scull D.S. on the 14 day of February 1753. the above described tract of land now situate in Flockland Township Berks County. Containing One hundred and Ninety seven acres and allowance of Six p Cent.
